John 14:1-3

'Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwellingplaces. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also.

Imagine the following two scenarios. In both scenarios you are going to have dinner guests. In one scenario your best friends or your family members are coming. You clean and prepare a nice meal because you want them to have a nice evening. But would you be nervous? Probably not, after all you have done something like this many times, you are familiar with them. And if we are being honest, we know that at some point the guests will go home.
